PROPOSITION 3 KEEPS THE CURRENT TAX RATES ON THE WEALTHIEST TOP 2% WITH STRICT ACCOUNTABILITY TO ENSURE EVERY DOLLAR GETS TO CLASSROOMS, NOT SACRAMENTO POLITICIANS.

PROTECT OUR SCHOOLS AND HEALTH CARE

Prop 3 protects our schools, our health care and our communities without raising taxes. For the past 14 years, the wealthiest 2% of Californians have paid marginally higher tax rates to help fund our schools and the programs California families and communities count on, from free school lunches, smaller class sizes and mental health counselors to children's health care and Medi-Cal.

Today, these revenues are critical to the state budget, raising around \$10 billion a year. But those rates are set to expire for the wealthiest Californians.

PROP 3 IS NOT A TAX INCREASE

Prop 3 simply extends the existing tax rates on the wealthiest 2% to protect our schools.

PROP 3 INCLUDES STRICT ACCOUNTABILITY

Prop 3 guarantees the money reaches the classroom, not Sacramento.

Funds go directly to local schools and community colleges. Politicians cannot touch it, redirect it, or spend a single dollar on bureaucracy or administrative overhead.

Every dollar is independently audited every year, and any official who misuses the money faces prosecution and criminal penalties.

PROP 3 PROTECTS PATIENTS

While these revenues go directly to local schools, the money also counts toward California's school funding guarantee, in turn freeing up billions of dollars to fund Medi-Cal, health care, children and other safety net programs.

Without Proposition 3, families could lose access to preventive health care and affordable prescription drugs, and the Medi-Cal coverage that millions of Californians rely on could be put at risk.

This funding has also helped prevent cuts during economic downturns by investing more in the state's Rainy Day Fund.

PROP 3 PROTECTS STUDENTS

Without Prop 3, California's 8 million public school and community college students face billions in cuts every year, including teacher layoffs, overcrowded classrooms and bigger class sizes.



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WE CAN'T AFFORD TO GIVE MILLIONAIRES AND BILLIONAIRES A TAX CUT

Letting the top tax rates expire would give millionaires and billionaires a massive tax cut at the expense of our classrooms, clinics and communities. They don't need one, and California can't afford one.

The Trump Administration already cut Californians' health care to fund tax cuts for billionaires. Prop 3 ensures we don't make this problem worse.
